

CALIFORNIA VISITATION GUIDELINES

To protect our patients, physicians, staff, volunteers and the community, the following guidelines are in place:

1. All visitors must wear a well-fitting medical/surgical face mask upon entry and at all times within the facility.
2. Each visitor, regardless of their vaccination status, is screened for fever, COVID-19 symptoms.

3. Fully vaccinated visitors must show proof of vaccination:

- COVID-19 Vaccination Record Card;
 - Includes: name of vaccinated person, type of vaccine, and date of last dose
- OR
- A photo of a Vaccination Record Card; OR
- A photo of the Vaccination Record Card stored on a phone or electronic device; OR
- Documentation of COVID-19 vaccination from a healthcare provider; OR
- Digital record that includes a QR code that when scanned by a SMART Health Card reader displays an individual's name, date of birth, vaccine dates and vaccine type.

4. Unvaccinated or incompletely vaccinated visitors:

- Must show documentation of a negative COVID test:
 - Negative antigen test: within one (1) day of visitation
 - Negative PCR test: within two (2) days of visitation
- With history of COVID within the prior 90 days may provide documentation of recovery and release from isolation in lieu of testing.
- An FDA-approved or EUA-authorized over-the-counter test (at-home test) is acceptable, but it must be conducted and observed on-site.
- For multiple consecutive visitations, visitors are required to provide proof of a negative test every third day (e.g.: testing is required on day one, day 4 and day 7, and so on).
